THE VICAR'S ADVISORY GROUP

As part of my commitment to lead our church with wisdom, prayerfulness, and accountability, I've invited a small Advisory Group to meet regularly with me. This informal group is made up of four trusted members of our Parochial Church Council (PCC) and exists to support me in thinking and praying through the everyday leadership of our parish.

The Advisory Group includes:

- Tom Raper our current Churchwarden
- Jackie Hird Licensed Lay Minister (Reader)
- Kevin Keefe a retired Churchwarden
- Eric Cairns a retired church planter

Each member brings valuable experience, insight, and a heart for the life and mission of our church. This group functions in the spirit of the traditional "churchwardens' meeting" (where the Vicar meets regularly with the wardens), but has been expanded to reflect the broader gifts and perspectives available within our PCC.

What is the role of the group?

This group is not a formal or independent decision-making body, nor does it hold authority over the PCC. It does, however, assist me in making the kinds of decisions that I am empowered and expected to make as Vicar - especially those concerning day-to-day leadership, pastoral priorities, and the spiritual life of the church.

Any matters that rightly belong to the PCC - for example, financial decisions, policy matters, or formal governance - will, as always, continue to be brought to the PCC for discussion and approval.

I'm deeply grateful for Tom, Jackie, Kevin, and Eric's willingness to serve in this way, and I invite you to join me in praying for them. Please also continue to pray for the whole PCC as we seek to discern God's will and lead our church with wisdom, unity, and grace.
